WHO CAN BE A DUAL ATHLETE?

Athletes aged 11 to 16 are eligible for Dual Athletics. To be eligible, athletes must be a current member of a LAANSW centre in the U12 to U17 age groups.

HOW DO I BECOME A DUAL ATHLETE?

Simply contact your local ANSW club and enquire about activating your LAANSW registration to dual registration. All ANSW clubs can be located on our website www.nswathletics.org.au. Simply click "Get Involved > Find a club" on the home page.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The annual dual registration fee has been waived by ANSW for the upcoming season. Athletes may have to pay a small club fee to join a club and access their resources. Each ANSW club sets these fees independently.

WHAT DO I WEAR?

Your club may allow you to wear your LAANSW Centre uniform while competing at senior competition (except NSW State Championships). Athletes will be required to wear their ANSW competition numbers at all ANSW meets. The number identifies registered athletes to officials and administration staff.
