

### Parent/Guardian Obligation Form

Please read the below information carefully. Print and sign the final sign off page and bring along to registration.

Parent/Guardian participation is mandatory and essential for the successful operation of HDLAC. There are many fun and easy ways to get involved, no matter what your experience is, and your children will love having you involved in their sport. Every parent should complete an additional duty once a month, and can travel around with their age groups the remainder of the time *if numbers permit*.

By signing this form, you are confirming you understand and agree that:

1. You are responsible for your children and a parent/guardian must be in attendance at the oval at all times during centre competition and training.
2. Each family must provide one parent/guardian helper at the centre competition at least every fortnight.
3. Each family must send one parent/guardian to participate in the setting up and putting away of equipment when scheduled to do so.

#### Set up duties

A weekly roster found on the website will detail which weeks your age group is required for set up. Email reminders will also be sent. One parent/guardian must arrive promptly at 6:30am to help put out competition equipment. Set up families must stay at the end of competition to assist with pack up. Assistants for the BBQ and Canteen must also be provided.



#### First Aiders



Certified first aiders are needed on competition day in case of accident or illness. If you are a qualified first aider, or interested in becoming one, please make note of this on the sign off page.

#### Coaches

Parents wanting to develop their coaching skills can support the centre in a number of ways, formally and informally. If this is of interest to you, please indicate this on the sign off page.



### Age Managers



Each group needs 2 nominated age managers to oversee their assigned age group each week and communicate important messages to the groups. Please check the website for the updated Age Manager list and indicate your interest on the sign off page.

### Key Assistant Roles

Each Saturday, a number of parents are required to undertake some key assistant roles. Training will be provided for all assistant roles and are a great way to be on the field with all the athletes.

Assisting roles include:

**Starters:** Easy as “On you MARKS, Set, GO!” A fun position out on the field, interacting with all the children and parent helpers.

**Computer operators:** Key in the race bibs at the end of each event and celebrate all the PBs and centre records with the groups. What’s more, you get a chair and shade.

**Track Marshall:** Help the age managers at the finish line to herd the kids and call out bib numbers to the computer operator. Dish out High Fives to all the tired children.

**Field Assistant:** Check all the field events have all the equipment they need and assist where required.



### Event Official



Would you like to train to be an event official for zone and region events? Who knows, you could be at the next Olympics judging the Long Jump! Most learning is online with participation at only a couple of carnivals required each season.

### Committee

A number of committee positions still require filling. The amount of commitment varies per role and many can be shared. 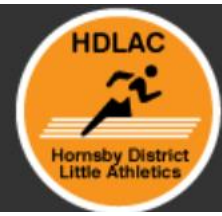




In addition to you understanding and agreeing to items 1, 2 and 3 on the first page:
